Match Timing and Duration:

All matches will be timed centrally. Independent timing is used in the case of significant injury time, at the direction of match umpires. Prior to each match, umpires and teams will be notified of:

- 5 minute warning
- 30 second warning – umpires are to call up their players
- 10 second warning
- Match commences on the siren
- All matches are x 12 minute quarters
- Breaks at quarter and three-quarter time – two minutes
- Half time break - three minutes

Rules:

All matches shall be played under the rules and regulations of the All Australian Netball Association, excluding the Modified Competition.

Club Secretaries will be provided with a copy of the GDNA Constitution and By-Laws. It is Club responsibility to be familiar with these documents. Queries can be directed to the Association via Club Secretaries.

Please note, the format of the Modified competition is designed to encourage young players to learn the skills of netball in a safe and structured environment, with maximum participation. Please see Modified Rules in the By-Laws.

MyNetball

GDNA uses MyNetball to manage competitions and player registration. Self-registration is compulsory for all players.

Working With Children Checks

Everyone working or volunteering with children must have a valid child-related screening. The GDNA Authorising Officer must site volunteer clearances.

Primary Carer

As per the rules of netball, each team must have a Primary Carer. GDNA requires each Primary Carer to be identified with a hi-vis vest.

GDNA Facilities

Entry:

- Entry is \$4.00 per person, cash only at gate. 14 and under free entry.
- Season passes are available to order (closing date 4 October 2020).
- Entry tickets/Season passes will be checked randomly during the season; please ensure you keep your gate ticket / season pass on person.
- No bikes, scooters, skateboards etc. are to be ridden in the complex.
- Children should be supervised at all times.
- The Gawler and District Netball Association is a smoke-free and alcohol-free venue.
- Please do not bring pets into the courts, unless they are 'Assistance Animals'.
- Bins are located around the courts, and teams are strongly encouraged to check they do not leave any rubbish behind after games.

Please remember driving speed on Hallam Drive and within the courts is 10kph (please note SA Police monitor this area regularly). We want to ensure the safety of everyone involved with netball and also those who use this area for cycling and walking etc.

As we expect high traffic at the end of each time slot, please allow plenty of time to enter the courts and find parking.

Please note, parking along the fence where there are two available parks, should be used for patrons intending to stay the entire night. Please do not park in the second space, where the first park has not been utilised, as this is wasting valuable space.

Excerpt of Extreme Weather Policy

Hot Weather...

All temperatures will be based on the Bureau of Meteorology “Roseworthy” readings www.bom.gov.au. The GDNA Management Committee will notify Club Secretaries by text message of hot weather guidelines and it is the club’s responsibility to communicate with its members.

When the temperature at 4.30pm is 36 degrees or over, all matches are to be abandoned. When the temperature at 4.30pm is 34 degrees – 35.9 degrees, matches will be modified i.e. quarters reduced and breaks increased.

The GDNA Management Committee reserves the right to cancel matches based on current weather information.
